Q7) Name two animals or habitats that have special protection in the BMR.

- Any from: Seals, seabirds, sea caves, rocky reefs

Q8) How can boats effect marine wildlife?

- The noise and movement from fast boats can scare marine animals. Sometimes, boats can even collide with whales, dolphins or seals.

Q9) What might happen if you leave litter on the beach?

- Animals might eat it or it could get washed into the sea.

- Cold waters from the north mix with warm waters from the south.
