- 1. What are Marine Protected Areas (MPAs)?
  - Areas of the ocean that are protected because they are important for nature, animals and people. This includes marine parks, fully protected marine areas, no-take zones and marine sanctuaries.
- 2. Name an important species or habitat that is protected in MPAs/Marine Parks? *Any of the following:* 
  - Coral reefs; seagrass beds; fish; sharks; lots of other marine creatures!
- 3. Name two reasons why Marine Parks are important.

## Any two of the following:

- Support sustainable tourism and recreation
- Keep coral reefs and ecosystems healthy
- Allow fish populations to grow
- Protect marine life from harm
- Marine life stays healthy for future generations
- 4. What can people not do in a Marine Park if it's fully protected? Why?
  - Fish, boat or dive. This is to prevent disturbance to marine life.
- 5. How much of the Dutch Caribbean is sea (in %)?
  - 99%
- 6. How much of the total Dutch Caribbean sea is currently protected (in %)?
  - 31%
- 7. What islands make up the *Yarari* Marine Mammal & Shark Sanctuary?
  - Bonaire, Saba and St. Eustatius
- 8. How much of the world's land and sea will hopefully be protected by 2030 (in %)?
  - 30%
- 9. What apex predator is studied by DCNA and why?
  - Sharks! They are studied to better understand them so we can protect them.
- 10. If you had to give someone advice based on what you have read today to protect our oceans, what would it be?
