- 1. Where are the two snorkel trails in Jersey?
 - Portelet Bay and Bouley Bay
- 2. How many species can be found in Jersey's sea?
 - 3,200
- 3. Name three species you can find on the snorkel trails.
 - Any of the following (and even more!):
 - Wrasse; blennies; cuttlefish; spider crab; seahorse; ray; catshark; seahorse; anemone
- 4. Name a marine habitat you can spot while snorkelling.
 - Any of the following:
 - Kelp; rocky reefs; seagrass; seaweed
- 5. How big is Jersey's tidal range?
 - 12m
- 6. Name three safety rules everyone should follow before going snorkelling.
 - Any of the following:
 - Snorkel when the tide is going out between mid to low-tide
 - Don't snorkel in bad weather
 - Check the tides and currents
 - Only snorkel if you are a strong swimmer Stay close to the shore
 - Be aware of moving vessels
 - Stay close to the shore

- Don't snorkel if you feel unwell
 - Never snorkel alone
- Protect yourself from the sun
- Leave your valuables somewhere safe
- Make sure you have the correct equipment that fits properly
- 7. How can you look after the sea and its marine life when you go snorkelling?
 - Make sure your fins don't hit anything below you
 - Don't touch any animals- the sea is their home!
 - Leave shells and rocks in the sea
 - Collect litter to put in the bin
- 8. How can you help scientists monitor biodiversity on the Jersey Snorkel Trails?
 - Downloading the 'Epicollect' app and adding information on what you see during your snorkel at Snorkel Portelet or Snorkel Bouley.
- 9. What is a No-Take Zone (NTZ) and where is the only NTZ in Jersey?
 - You can't fish or take anything natural out of the water or on the beach. This is to create a safe sanctuary for marine life. Portelet is currently the only NTZ in Jersey.
- 10. What do you think the most important message in this factfile is and why?
